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HOW TO PLAY

1. Find every word

Each word search lists the words hidden in the grid. Circle each one. Words run across, down, and diagonally; in the harder puzzles toward the back they may also read backwards.

2. Read the hidden verse

Here is the golden thread: once every listed word is circled, read the LEFT-OVER letters left to right, top to bottom. Together they spell a verse of Scripture – a little reward waiting inside every puzzle.

3. Follow the thread to Christ

Each section ends with a Golden Thread Match. Draw a line from each Old Testament shadow to the way it is fulfilled in Jesus.

4. Turn to the Answer Key

At the back you will find every solved grid, the hidden verse spelled out, a “Did You Know?” fact, and a short reflection to carry with you.
